ARRIVAL

Please do not arrive on site before 5pm Friday Evening – anyone who does arrive before then will be politely asked to come back later or assist with set-up.

Once on site, please park up and then report to Event Control. Please park as directed and sensibly.

Weapons checking will also take place at Event Control.

ACCOMODATION

There is no player bunk accommodation, therefore, please remember to bring suitable tentage, camping gear, bedding etc.

CATERING & BAR

Catering will be provided by The Banqueting Club. Catering for the weekend is £20 and meal tickets will be available for purchase at Event Control. The menu will be made available at muster.dragonsfaction.org.

Unfortunately, due to a licensing issue, we will not be able to provide a bar for this event as previously planned. Please accept our apologies and feel free to bring your own alcohol as usual.

THINGS TO BRING

Don't forget you'll need all the usual LRP safe weapons, kit, any lammies you want to use (no lammie, no effect), and lore sheets your character needs. Lammies will need to be attached to a suitable phys rep. Also, don't forget to bring any OOC items you may need, such as medication, a change of clothes, etc.

LAMMIES & LORE SHEETS

Please declare any lammies you want to use at the event to a member of Dragons NPC Command when you arrive at the event.

Please remember that if you do not have the relevant lore sheet for a skill it is very likely that you will not be able to use that skill at the event.

LINEARS & MONSTERING

As with previous parliaments we will be running a number of linears throughout the weekend. To make these linears as enjoyable as possible we would encourage everyone to monster at least one linear if possible.

There will be sign-up sheets for monstering at Event Control.

The linears will take place at the following times:

Saturday morning.

Saturday afternoon.

Saturday evening.

Sunday morning.

If you have any queries about the linears or monstering please speak to Chris Ellingsen or one of the other Dragons Command Team.

Plot details of the linears will be seeded in throughout the weekend.

TIME IN & IC AREAS

Time in is currently planned for 8pm on Friday, we will try and notify you of any changes to this (there will be a call out of Time-in to notify you when it actually starts).

Time in on Saturday and Sunday will be 10am. Time out on Friday and Saturday will be 2am and 2pm on Sunday.

Please note only the main field will be IC for the entirety of the event. All other areas of the site will be used as linear areas and therefore should not be entered unless you are going on the linear.

HERB LORE

As with campaign events, PCs with the Herb Lore OS will not be given the opportunity to select herbs before time-in. Instead, the IC areas will be seeded with herbs they can collect IC during the event.

These herbs will consist of a phys rep and a lammie describing the herb and its effect when used.

Please take both the phys rep and the lammie when collecting the herb. When you use a herb, please pass both the phys rep and lammie to a ref at the next suitable and convenient moment.

If you do not have the Herb Lore OS please ignore the herbs - you are unable to determine that they are of any particular use or interest.

REFS & MARSHALLS

Should you require a ref, Chris Ellingsen and Jon Conway will be available to drop out of character should you need them for reffing duties.

For those of you assisting with reffing and marshalling, please remember your Ref/Marshall card.

DEPARTURE

Everyone will need to be off-site by 5pm Sunday.

FIRST AID

First aiders for the event will be – amongst others – Vicky Conway and Jon Conway.

MOBILE PHONES

PLEASE DON'T LET MOBILE PHONES SPOIL YOURS – OR ANYONE ELSE'S – ROLE-PLAY EXPERIENCE.

Please switch them off or have them on silent in IC areas and conduct any calls you need to make in OOC areas.
